- In reviewing officer roles as are currently listed in by-laws, some updates to VP are needed, including updating "Spaghetti Supper" to "Musical Extravaganza"
- Also proposing a committee to take on "Public Relations"
 - \circ $\;$ This role would take on Social Media coordination as well as Web Master $\;$
 - Looking to have this role/committee be a person/people who are tech savvy, could do on the fly communications/pushes for fundraising, also able to attend all meetings
 - Proposal to integrate this as an additional board position
 - Suggestion was also given to run this as a committee role that works directly with VP
 - Would the board still be "functional" without this role filled?
 - Suggestion to reach out to Holly Johnson (former U5MP Secretary) to see if she would propose a cost to fill this role through her company if this role is not filled by a volunteer. It is very much a need to have this filled at this point
 - Proposal to have a volunteer from each High School to help manage this, be the point of contact for each high school and coordinating junior high
 - Directors could send details on fundraising, concerts and additional events
 - After discussion, it was decided to have this be a committee run through VP role. Emily will work on securing any additional interest in assisting with this. Will review in a year to see what changes might be needed

- Feedback on past year
 - Things that went well, things that could have gone better
 - Focus seemed to rely solely on the Referendum and our support behind this, which makes it difficult to truly assess what was viewed as "what went well" or not
 - Representation/Presence was a great addition to each event/performance district-wide
 - Having a few mins to speak to who we are, what we do, why we need parents to be involved
 - Need to keep momentum going beyond Musical Extravaganza each year
 - Remind parents of benefits of organization
 - Replace stigma of "PTO" organization, help parents understand the involvement looks different than the elementary level, it's more than just representing your program at a meeting

- Suggestion to create a Google Doc to have directors share with families to collect emails for Music Parents to share communications
 - Have emails sent regularly to directors for them to share with families that also link back to Website/Facebook/Instagram
 - Board will also be looking into possibility of utilizing Band App to help streamline communication as well
- More time should be devoted in each meeting to sharing reports of what is happening at each building/program
 - Suggestion to move this in at the beginning of meetings, BUT keep it timeboxed
 - Because there is a lot of overlap in what the different groups are doing, have parent reps bring "highlights" to celebrate each program
 - Full notes should still be sent by directors to go in to meeting minutes
- More intentionality in sending meeting reminders to director's with more notice
- Highlight during each meeting to "showcase" or "celebrate" last month's event, large upcoming events (ie: ILMEA, etc)
- Continuing to think of ways to draw more attendance after Extravaganza/Winter Break
 - Large drop off occurs after Musical Extravaganza is completed
 - Should Music Parents update the attendance policy?
 - This has not been enforced due to changes in the Spaghetti Super to Musical Extravaganza as there is no longer an "overage" to disburse, all programs receive funds equally
 - Previously, attendance requirement only applied to junior high programs in order to get the "overage"
